

COMPACFLT REMEMBRANCE BARGE TOUR REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

The USPACFLT Historic Remembrance Tour has been scheduled for the Class of 11985 for Wednesday, 30 August. Check in time is 0830 at the USPACFLT Aiea Landing (Boathouse). The tour begins at 0900. Guests must have prior reservations to take the tour. Proper ID is required.

****No standby list is maintained nor walk-ins accepted****

This two-hour tour is fully narrated and includes a visit to the Boathouse museum and viewing of a 23-minute movie on the attack on Pearl Harbor. The boat tour follows with a tour around Ford Island and a stop at the Arizona Memorial.

Spouses of deceased or deployed military personnel may sponsor and **MUST** escort guests.

Attire for all active duty military personnel (**including those on leave**):

Navy: Dress White (E6 & Below) /Summer White (E7 & Above)

Marine Corps: Service "C"

Army: Army Green ASU/Tropical "B"

Coast Guard: Tropical Blue

Air Force: Service Uniform/Class "B"

MILITARY PERSONNEL ON LEAVE – LEAVE PAPERS MUST BE PRESENTED UPON CHECK-IN

Those not in uniforms must wear appropriate attire. (Remember, you are paying respects to our fallen heroes -- wear proper Memorial attire.) Those not in compliance with Uniform Requirements or Civilian Attire Rules will be refused entry on USPACFLT's Barge Tour by Boat House OIC.

Flip Flops of any kind

Sandals without back strap

Short-Shorts

Cut-off jeans/pants/shorts

Drug/Alcohol related tops

Tank Tops

Please observe the following for safety measures:

Children MUST be a minimum of **EIGHT years of age to embark the Remembrance Barge Tour**

No backpacks, bags, purses or camera bags are permitted on the Arizona Memorial.

Cameras are acceptable without cases.

The USPACFLT Boat House is not equipped to accommodate wheelchairs or walkers; however, the National Park Service is able to provide disabled/handicapped-viewing opportunities.
